Greenlam Industries suggests ways to enliven homes during the monsoons

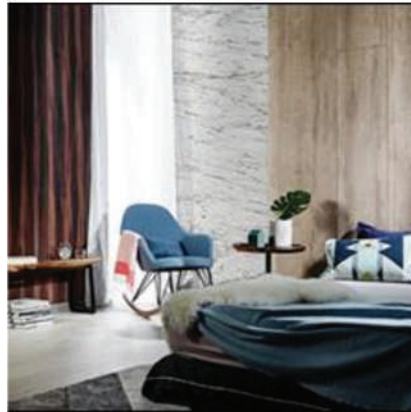
Feel the Monsoon Vibes in Greenlam Industries' décor trends for the season
