For entrance hallways, create an interesting, layered look and feel, and throw in a splash of character. If you are looking for a vintage spirit, herringbone pattern can add an element of wow to study rooms or libraries as well!

A chevron is very different from a herringbone. A chevron is formed when tiles or planks of the same size and trapezoidal shape are placed in parallel 'V'-patterns to form repetitive arrowhead zig-zags. If you want to add a touch of class to your bathroom, pair this chevron pattern with ceramics or glass to create a marvellous persona. Chevron is also a terrific way to bring some originality to an otherwise common wood floor. Creating a chevron pattern from the wood planks is a form of parquetry which makes for a dramatic and beautiful view when someone steps into your home.

Checkmate!

While wood floors have an appeal to them, checkered floors have the potential to sweep you off your feet. They provide a soothing neoclassical feeling to an interior. There is a touch of nirvana in the way a checkered floor makes you feel. It is both versatile and neutral, that gives structure to a spacious room and grace to a confined one. For the ones who prefer subtlety in design, you can use two similar colour tones like platinum or greys and give your room a warm and homely feel. If you are a fan of the classic black and white checkerboard floor, this wooden floor look is sure to uplift your room.
